4. A #4 drawn like a **church** pew with a little cross on the pew back reminds us of church on the Sabbath Day. We have our *conscience* instructed by the Holy Spirit as we listen to the Word in church.

5. A #5 drawn with a face and a crown on top representing King Jesus. When God is honored as King and Sovereign, you have a Biblical form of government.

6. A #6 drawn like a coiled poisonous snake that can kill. Centralized government is deadly, but local government is God's way, bringing liberty and blessing.

7. A #7 looks like a "hangman's" scaffold. Benjamin Franklin said, after signing the *Declaration of Independence*, "We need to hang together, or surely we will hang separately." If the signers of the *Declaration* did not continue to work together in unity, they were in danger of being executed as traitors to Great Britain.
